While on active patrol, I observed a white vehicle, Illinois registration # [REDACTED], on Grand Avenue at 75th Avenue, with the passengers in the rear of the vehicle with no seatbelts fastened. I activated my emergency lights and conducted a traffic stop on the 7800 block of Grand Avenue. I requested another unit to my location due to their being four occupants inside the vehicle. I then approached the vehicle and spoke to the driver, Julian Batula, m/w, 08/01/89, and requested his driver's license and proof of insurance. Julian was able to provide me with a valid Illinois driver's license and valid proof of insurance. I asked Julian where he was going. Julian said he and his friends were going to Gene and Judes to get food. While speaking to Julian, I detected a strong odor of cannabis emitting from the vehicle. I asked Julian if there was any type of contraband inside the vehicle. Julian said there was nothing inside the vehicle and I could search the vehicle if I wanted to.

Officer Chaurize, Officer Zelasco, and Officer Ikis #644 (River Grove Police Dept.) arrived on scene.


I approached the vehicle again and requested all occupants to exit the vehicle. All occupants exit the vehicle as instructed. I asked Julian again if I could search his vehicle. Julian gave permission for officers to search his vehicle.


I conducted a pat down on Julian and the other occupants in the vehicle, for officer safety purposes. The following are the other occupants who were in the vehicle:

No contraband was recovered from any of the occupants who were inside the vehicle. I asked Julian again if there was any contraband inside the vehicle. Julian self admitted he has a grinder, used to chop up cannabis, inside his vehicle.

I asked Julian if he was under the influence of cannabis. Julian said he did not smoke cannabis today. Officer Ikis conducted field sobriety tests on Julian. Officer Ikis advised me Julian was not under the influence.

Officer Zelasco conducted a search on the vehicle and recovered a grinder, rolling papers, and a glass pipe with burnt cannabis inside of it. The grinder also contained cannabis residue.

I advised Julian he was under arrest for being in possession of drug paraphernalia. I placed Julian into custody by handcuffing, checking for fit, and double-locking the handcuffs. I placed Julian in the rear of squad #348.

Officer Zelasco confiscated the drug paraphernalia for evidentiary value.

I asked Julian if he was the registered owner of the vehicle. Julian said the vehicle is registered to his parents. I parked and secured Julian's vehicle. Julian's cellular telephone and vehicle keys were recovered from the vehicle and would later be placed with Julian's property.

All other occupants of the vehicle were clear through LEADS and sent on their way without further incident.

I transported Julian to the Elmwood Park Police Station, escorted him into the booking area, and processed him with all the necessary prisoner screening forms. I then placed Julian into cell #A2.


Commander Pisciotto took photographs of the drug paraphernalia. (See attached photographs).

Officer Zelasco inventoried the drug paraphernalia into the BEAST system for evidentiary value. Officer Zelasco then generated a criminal complaint.

I fingerprinted, photographed, and processed Julian according to Elmwood Park Police procedures. Julian was given the copy of the criminal complaint with a warning citation, advised of his court information, and released on bond.


