Dear Mr. Utsler:

I am in receipt of your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et. seq.*) (hereinafter referred to as "FOIA"), request received by the Village of Elmwood Park on May 3, 2010 for, "...the information contained in the previous police report by Lena Pizzo."

Records responsive to your request are enclosed. However, certain information has been deemed exempt from disclosure under the FOIA, and has been redacted from the records provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of the FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. Private information is defined in the FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2 (c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers including social security numbers, home or personal telephone numbers and home addresses have been redacted from the records with which you are being provided.

Section 7 (1) (d) (vi) of the FOIA provides that, "Records in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement agency or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes..." are exempt from disclosure, but only to the extent that disclosure would, "...endanger the life or physical safety of law enforcement personnel or any other person..." Consequently, information that would endanger the life or physical safety of those who have furnished information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has not been provided.


