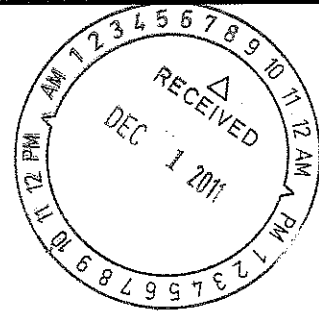

Dear Ms. Sutter:

On Sunday, November 27, 2011, two uniformed Elmwood Park police officers appeared at Elmwood Park resident Michael Warnock's door at 2417 N. 75th Avenue to question him concerning an allegation that he illegally trespassed on Village property. The officers stated that a report was received that he had trespassed upon the public works yard that morning, and, further, that "He'd better not lie to them because he was caught on surveillance video." Resident Michael Warnock sent a letter to our organization with the above stated information.

Pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information request I request the following:

1. A copy of all reports or other documents related to the above described incident.
2. The names and badge numbers of the two officers that came to Mr. Warnock's house.
3. A copy of all surveillance videos taken at the public works property from 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, November 23, 2011 through 9:00 a.m. on November 28, 2011.
