The Village of Elmwood Park will apply for funding under Illinois' Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) IKE-Disaster Recovery Program to construct a floodwater storage facility consisting of a concrete box culvert along Bloomingdale Ave. between 72<sup>nd</sup> Court and 74<sup>th</sup> Avenue. The box culvert will store excess runoff during heavy rainstorms until the combined sewer line has sufficient capacity to drain the excess stormwater. This project will benefit public health and safety in Elmwood Park by reducing the risk of flooding, sewer backups and combined sewer overflows.

The proposed project cost is estimated to total \$750,000.00. The CDBG-IKE grant award sought on behalf of the project, if approved, would total \$750,000.00 towards the funding needed for this project.

The Village of Elmwood Park invites public comments concerning the above-described project, and will accept comments through January 28, 2010.
