SHE LOOKED UP FROM SECURING HER DAUGHTER AND SAW ROJAS HAD BACKED INTO HER CAR AND WAS LEAVING. [REDACTED] CALLED 911 AS ROJAS LEFT THE AREA. [REDACTED] THEN CALLED ROJAS TO INFORM HIM SHE HAD CALLED THE POLICE.</p> <p>I CHECKED THE VEHICLE FOR DAMAGE AND DISCOVERED THE PLASTIC LICENSE PLATE FRAME HAD BROKEN AND THE FRONT LICENSE PLATE WAS BENT. THERE WAS NO DAMAGE OBSERVED TO THE FRONTEND OF THE VEHICLE'S BODY.</p> <p>I THEN SPOKE TO CEZAR ROJAS (m/w DOB [REDACTED] LKA [REDACTED], DL# [REDACTED]) ROJAS ADMITTED HE DID "TAP" THE CAR BUT DID NOT DO IT ON PURPOSE. HE EXPLAINED HE HAD JUST ENDED A LONG CUSTODY BATTLE WITH [REDACTED] THAT COST HIM A LOT OF MONEY. HE SAID HE WOULD NEVER HIT THE CAR INTENTIONALLY WITH HIS DAUGHTER IN THE CAR.</p> <p>I SPOKE TO [REDACTED] AND EXPLAINED HOW TO PETITION THE COURT FOR AN INDEPENDENT ORDER OF PROTECTION. [REDACTED] DID NOT WANT A MOTOR VEHICLE CRASH REPORT. UPON COMPLETION OF THIS REPORT I RETURNED TO PATROL.</p>
