Dear Ms. Jajko:

On September 2, 2015, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Property 2106 North 72<sup>nd</sup> Court  
Police reports on all activity (1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> floor) Past 9 months[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including driver's license numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including victims' names and identifying information, and the race of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, “[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes ...” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would: ... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies ... .” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who have filed complaints with or who have provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

On 04/21/2015 at 2117 hours I responded to the police station lobby for a residential burglary report. Upon arrival I spoke with [REDACTED] (m [REDACTED]) who told me the following in summary: [REDACTED] left his front door unlocked so Nicor would have access to his apartment for gas meter replacement. All the buildings gas meters are located in his unit. At 0645 he spoke with one the the Nicor employees and let him know the front door is open for access to the meters. [REDACTED] had placed cameras in his unit a few days prior to keep and eye on the Nicor employees that would be in his unit. At 0800 hours his phone alerted stating there was activity on the cameras. He checked the cameras and observed his upstairs neighbors in his apartment going through his personal items. He contacted his landlord, [REDACTED], and told her what he observed on the video cameras. [REDACTED] told him to wait until he returns from work and she will go and speak with the other residents. [REDACTED] returned home at 1800 hours and met [REDACTED] was unable to make contact with the upstairs neighbors. [REDACTED] went through his belongings and discovered he was missing \$1100 USC. At 1930
