On August 27, 2015, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Police Report Stolen Property on 8-14-15 or about.
(7804 Sunset)[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including a driver's license number, a home or personal telephone number, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

I spoke with [REDACTED] who stated he owned a house in northern Wisconsin and was a victim of a burglary last week, which he reported to the local sheriff's police department (Douglas Co Sheriff report #15DC03579). He stated he suspected his ex-girlfriend [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] to be responsible. He stated he believed his missing items would be for sale at her garage sale today. He stated [REDACTED] moved out of the house approximately 15 years ago and abandoned her property. He stated some of the property missing used to be hers and he did not care about it but the other property was strictly his. He stated forced entry was made to his house via a window. He described several items specifically a Vermont Castings grill, blue in color with a heavy lift top, a white refrigerator, GE brand with a dent on the front side, spraypainted over. He also stated other items such as silverware, a mixer, a mirror and bowls were taken.





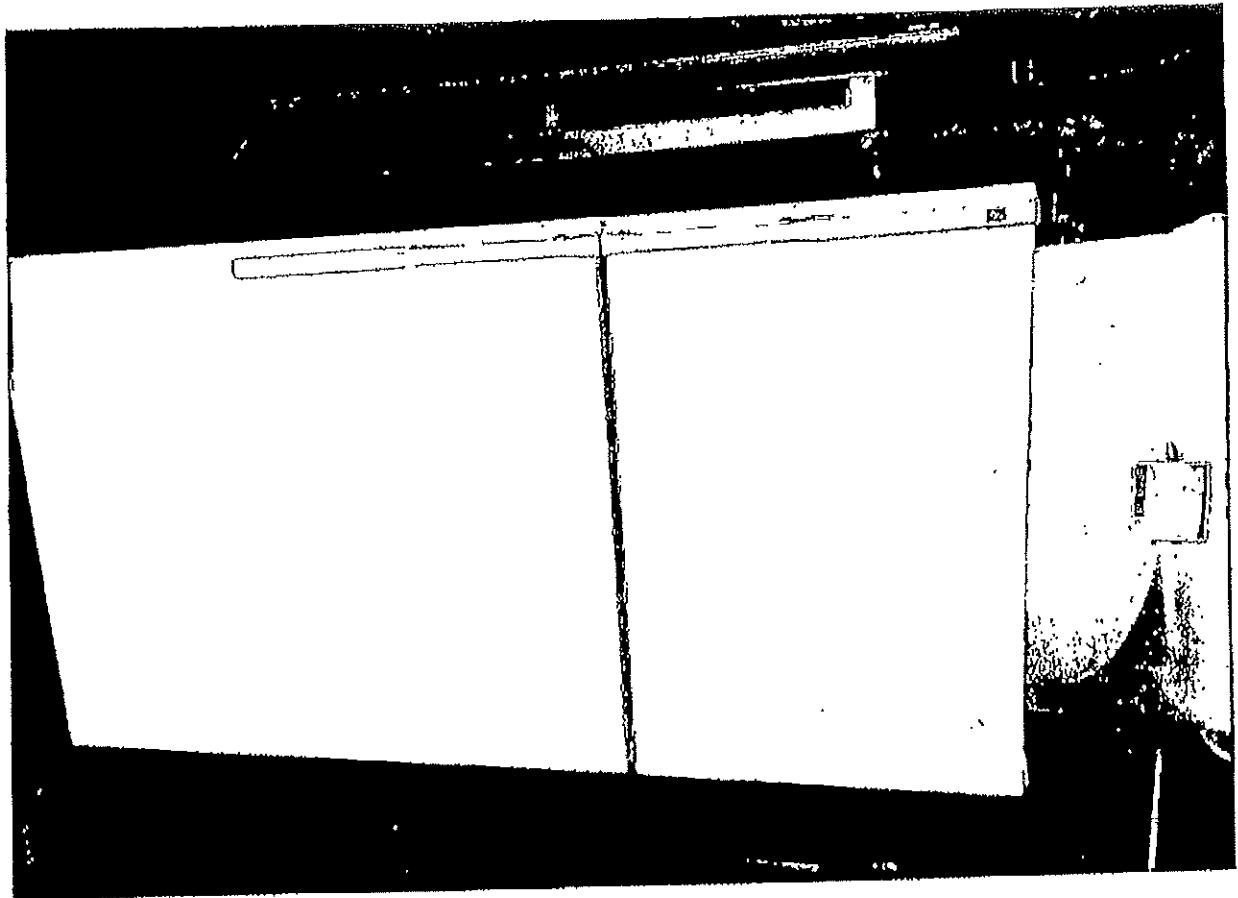
I advised [REDACTED] there was no criminal case. [REDACTED] stated he would write the property off as a loss.

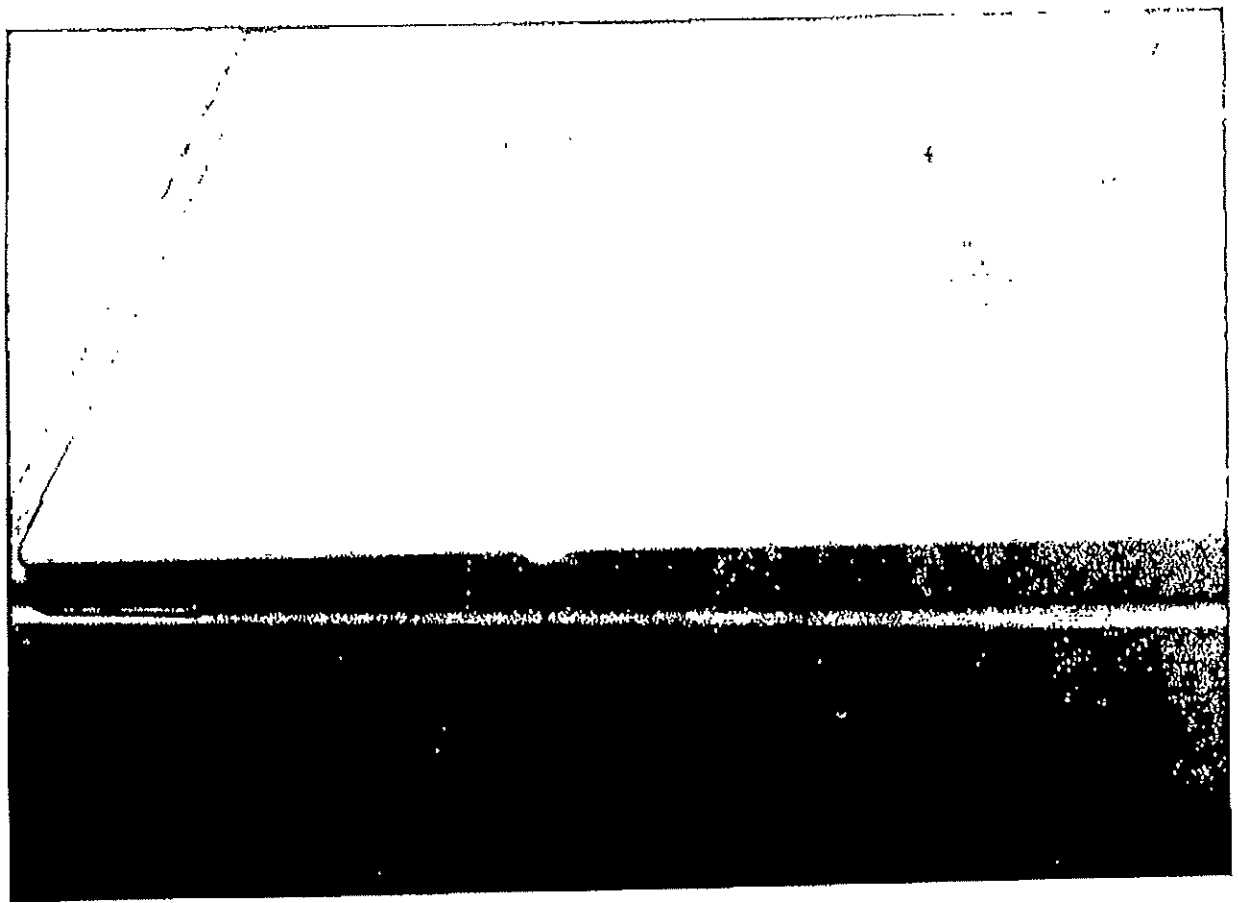

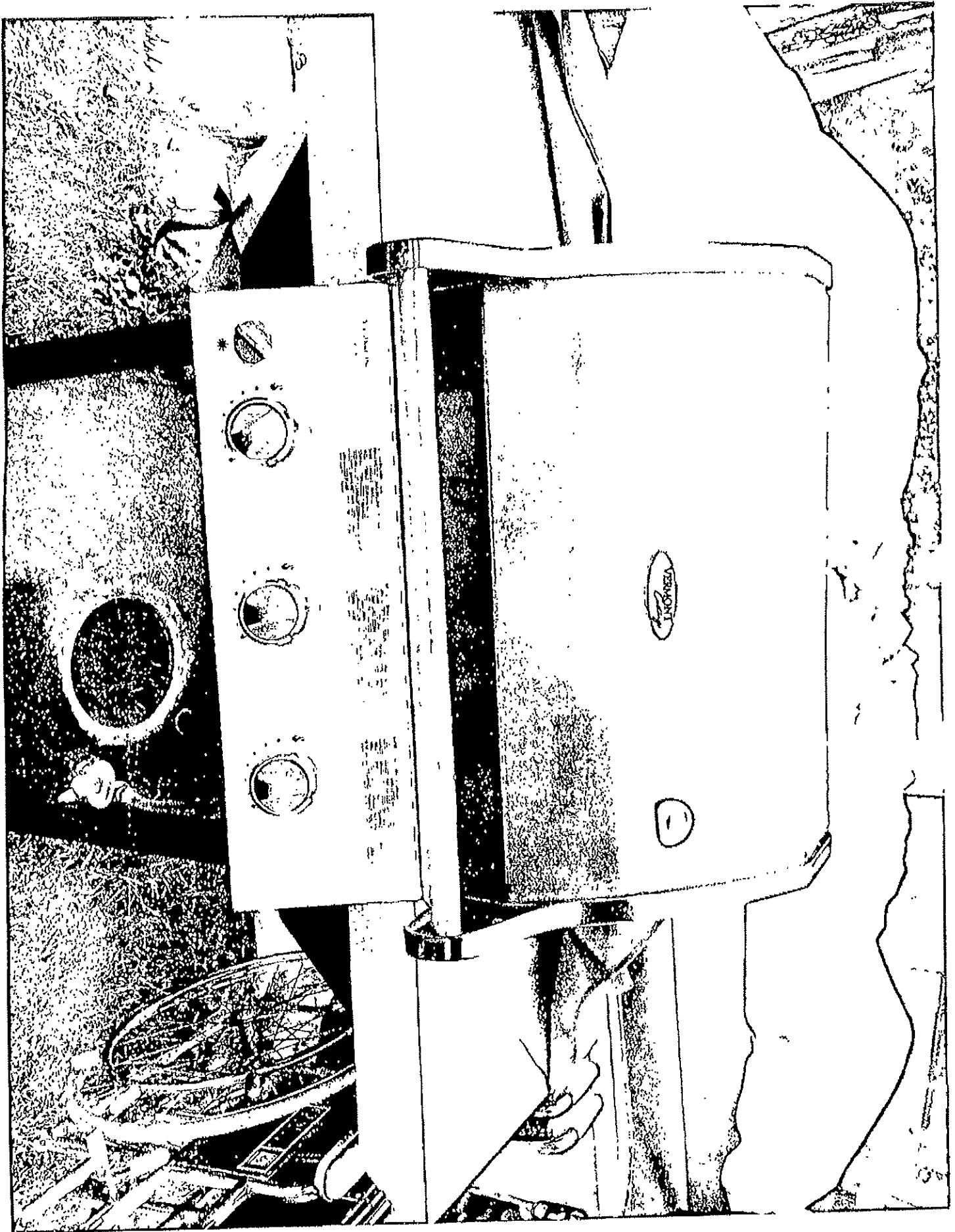
