The Recreation Department will be funding the rehabilitation of the baseball diamonds at John Mills Park, Elm Middle School and hopefully at Bambi Park.

The President spoke with Pastor Herb Hayek of St. Vincent's Parish to work out a plan where the local businesses along North Avenue would use the St. Vincent's parking lot for valet parking. The President thanked the parish for having this discussion and will have more information at a later date.

Lastly, President Silvestri announced that Village Manager John J. Dalicandro won the "Jack Williams Inter-Governmental Award" from the West Central Municipal Conference and will be receiving that award at their annual dinner in May.
