## **Village Board approves Fang to fill Trustee post**

*"Best choice at this time for this position"*

ELMWOOD PARK, IL -- The Village Board has approved the appointment of Albert J. Fang Jr. as trustee to complete the term of long time trustee Alan Bennett. Village President Peter Silvestri nominated Fang after receiving four applications for the post. The Board was required by law to fill the vacancy within 60 days of Bennett's resignation.

"I believe Mr. Fang was the best choice at this time for this position," Silvestri said. "He has served as a member of the Board of Education for the past six years, representing the people of Elmwood Park, as well as Elmwood Park itself on various regional education cooperatives."

Mr. Fang continues to serve as a director of the Chamber of Commerce and the newly reactivated Civic Foundation. He plans to resign from the school board in order to devote his full attention to his duties on the Village Board.

"In these challenging times, it is imperative that we always work for the betterment of our village," Silvestri continued. "As a dedicated public servant, Mr. Fang has shown his willingness to work for a better tomorrow. He will serve admirably as a trustee."
