ELMWOOD PARK – Elmwood Park residents and small businesses can take advantage of the lowest possible discounted electric rates by enrolling in the village's new electric aggregation program by June 28. The village is partnering with First Energy Solutions to offer the voluntary opt-in program.

"We want our residents and small businesses to know that they're getting the best deal available when it comes to their electricity provider," Village President Angelo "Skip" Saviano said. "They have a choice. There is no cost to sign up and no penalty to drop out. It's just a great opportunity for our residents to save money."

"If you enroll in this program by June 28 you can be certain that your electric rates will remain fixed through July of next year and will never be higher than ComEd's rates," Saviano said.

Residents can also enroll by calling FirstEnergy Solutions at [1-888-651-5200](tel:1-888-651-5200) Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. There is a mail-in enrollment option available to print out on the Elmwood Park website as well.

Residents who take advantage of the opt-in program will still receive their monthly electric bill from ComEd. Switching to First Energy should be seamless, with no service interruptions or service calls required.
