It marks the start of several events the Village is hosting to tie in with the Centennial Celebration for Elmwood Park.

"We're excited to see an evening set aside for the kids," Trustee Angie Stranges said. Stranges is a member of the village's Arts & Special Events Committee. "All of the ice cream will be donated by Mori Milk & Ice Cream Company. We'll also be showing the movie *Despicable Me 2*, which should be a lot of fun."

The ice cream social is for Elmwood Park residents ages 3 to 12. Children must be accompanied by an adult.

The Village is also preparing for a special Memorial Day observance this year. The ceremony at Veteran's Garden on Conti Parkway will feature the dedication of the LCpl Nickolas Daniels Memorial. The ceremony will take place at 10 a.m. on May 26.

"Nick Daniels gave his life in defense of our country, and we wanted to pay tribute to him along with all of our residents who've made the ultimate sacrifice," Village President Angelo "Skip" Saviano said.

Looking ahead to June, The Circle Car Show is set for Friday, June 13, from 6 p.m. - 9 p.m. at the Conti Parkway Inner Circle, off of 76th and Grand Avenues. Plenty of vintage cars, trucks and motorcycles will be on display along with music and food and beverages.
