**ELMWOOD PARK** – Residents and neighbors have one final chance this year to enjoy shopping at the Village's Farmers Market on Sunday, October 26, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. The market is held in Central Park at Fullerton Ave. and North 75th Ave.

"Our final Farmers Market for 2014 is a special one because it's geared toward kids," Village Trustee Angela Stranges said. "Children can come between 10 a.m. and noon and take part in games and win prizes, get their face painted or get a balloon animal. It's always a fun and successful event."

The markets have been held every second and fourth Sundays throughout the summer and fall, giving residents and those from neighboring communities an opportunity to buy locally and sustainably-grown produce. Vendors include growers of fresh fruits and vegetables, flowers and specialty items, such as cheeses and chocolates.

On October 31, the Village will again host a special Halloween party for kids from 4 p.m. to 6 p.m. at the Parks and Recreation building, 2 West Conti Parkway. Children from pre-school through 6th grade may participate, free of charge.

"We want kids to dress up and come ready to have fun," Stranges said. "We'll have games and prizes, plus the first 200 kids to arrive will get a free pumpkin which they can then decorate."
