ELMWOOD PARK – Residents of Elmwood Park will have the opportunity to jump start spring cleaning with free unlimited garbage pickup during the week of April 14, the village has announced.

"We feel this is the ideal time to offer this service, especially after we've all had to deal with such a harsh winter," Village President Angelo "Skip" Saviano said. "We want residents to take advantage of the free, unlimited garbage pickup and dispose of all those unwanted items taking up space in their basements and attics."

From boxes to old furniture, appliances and carpet, homeowners can dispose of all kinds of household items on their normal garbage pickup day during the week April 14. Items will be picked up free of charge, and refuse stickers are not required.

Paint cans, tires, electronics and construction debris such as wood and bricks require special disposal and will not be removed during Spring Cleanup Week.

The Village will host a shredding, tire and electronics drop-off on Saturday, April 19, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. in the Village Parking lot, 11 Conti Parkway. A shredding truck will be on hand for anyone wanting to shred items such as old bank statements, receipts and other documents. There will be stations to dispose of old tires and electronics as well.

"We know this has been a huge success in the past," Saviano said. "We look forward to providing residents with this opportunity to keep our village clean, safe and beautiful."
