ELMWOOD PARK – The third annual Elmwood Park Fall Fest expands to three days this year, giving residents and visitors one last opportunity of the year to enjoy a weekend of outdoor food and entertainment.

The event takes place from 5 p.m. to 11 p.m. on Friday, September 18, from 12 p.m. to 11 p.m. on Saturday, September 19 and from 12 p.m. to 10 p.m. on Sunday, September 20.

"We're building on the success of the past two years of Fall Fest and realized that our residents really wanted the event to go a little longer, so that's why we're extending it to a third day," Trustee Jonathan Zivojnovic said. "The weather should still be quite comfortable, perfect for the music and activities."

Fall Fest will be held on Diversey Avenue between 73rd and 74th Avenues. Fun for the whole family, it will feature a variety of food from local vendors as well as beer and wine.
