Dear Mr. Hart:

On October 31, 2019, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"A police report that Elmwood Park Police Officer Anthony Alequin took on 10/3/19 report #19-25-2521 involving...and a missing rental car..."

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2 (c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers such as driver's license numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, an individual's race, a victim's name and identifying

Section 7 (1) (d) (iv) of FOIA provides that "[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes..." are exempt from disclosure, "but only to the extent that disclosure would...unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies..." Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who have filed complaints with or who have provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.





On 10/03/2019, at approximately 1606 hours, I was dispatched to Enterprise Rentals at 7807 W. Grand Ave., Elmwood Park, IL., to speak with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] said customer [REDACTED] is in possession of one of their rental vehicles, Ontario Canada registration CDMF493 (VIN: 3C4PDDFG0JT172807), and has not returned it, despite telephone contacts explicitly stating the vehicle needs to be returned and mailing of a certified demand letter to return the vehicle.

[REDACTED] looked at the rental notes for the vehicle and said his Area Manager spoke with [REDACTED] via telephone on August 28th, and she agreed to return the vehicle.
